Some highlights of our recent achievements:

 - Launched in September of 2024 to raise funds for our new fire station, we have successfully raised \$1.53 million towards our \$8 million goal.

- **Operational Costs and Equipment:** Continuous funding is crucial for covering essential operational costs and ensuring our equipment is always up to date and ready for any situation.
- **New Fire Station:** The Ignite the Future campaign is underway to raise the necessary funds for our new fire station.

As our community continues to grow, the demands on our department are increasing, and our current facilities are no longer sufficient to meet the needs of our expanding population. We are excited to share an update on our capital campaign, IGNITE the FUTURE - Building Tomorrow's Fire Station Today.

- To date, we have successfully raised \$1.53 million
- The land for our new fire station, located on Stepney's Lane between Routes 214 and 2, was approved last year, and site work has begun.
- Architectural plans have been approved.
- We anticipate breaking ground in 2026.



The "IGNITE the FUTURE" campaign is more than a fundraising effort; it is an investment in the future safety and well-being of Edgewater and its surrounding communities. The new fire station will feature:

- Adequate equipment storage, vehicle bays, and living quarters
- Modern fire prevention and safety standards

- Capacity for future growth in personnel and equipment
- Larger and improved training facilities
- A community gathering space

As the sole fire department in Edgewater, with 25 dedicated career personnel and over 100 volunteers, we have courageously faced every challenge in protecting our homes, families, businesses, and community. - Fireboat 2: 54 calls


